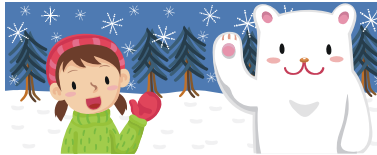
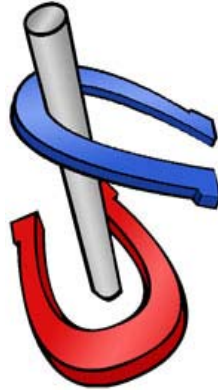

Brian also helped us negotiate favorable hotel rates in Greenville and acts in an advisory role to assist NHPA members in making travel arrangements. We appreciate his contributions.

I had the pleasure of pitching in the Tony Kucharski Memorial Tournament in Union on September 28th. I would like to compliment the club members on keeping the courts in such great condition. Dave Emrick kept two scores all afternoon to keep us going. If you have not pitched in Union, you should visit next year.

I would also like to compliment our newest officers that include Darryl Miller, Amy Miller, and Cindy Rose. All three are enthusiastic and work very hard to promote our sport. I would also like to thank our departing officer, Ray Welsh. Ray has worked tirelessly to promote pitching in the Canton area. Proposed Bylaws Changes and Convention Voting Results

Please find below a *summary* of the NHPA Convention delegate voting for each of the 10 Proposed NHPA Bylaws Changes that were discussed and voted on. A 2/3 majority vote (76 votes) was required for proposals to be passed. If you wish to see a more complete copy of the text information, please check earlier issues of Newline Magazine or the NHPA Website. This same information was also included in each of the delegate packets and posted at our recent Ohio State Tournament/Convention.

PBC #1 – Article III, Sec. 8 – Any member may be suspended for:

Discussion... Should Sections f. and g. be added?

Section f. Un-sportsman-like conduct while participating in or attending a sanctioned event.

Yes votes = 109 or No votes = 5 PASSED

Section g. Violating agreed-to NHPA forum guidelines when submitting/responding to posts to the NHPA forum.

Yes votes = 36 or No votes = 78 FAILED

PBC #2 – Article III, Sec. 9 – (On Length of Suspensions)

Change "may be suspended for one year." to "may be suspended for up to one year."

Yes votes = 110 or No votes = 4 PASSED

PBC #3 – Article III, Sec. 10 – (On Suspensions, this PBC adds more complete information about suspensions and allows for more direction to Charter Officers for dealing with minor Rules violations)

Yes votes = 112 or No votes = 2 PASSED

PBC #4 - Article IV, Sec. 2.c 4. – (Duties of Sec/Treas, re fiscal year reporting)

A change of wording for Sec.2.c 4, to allow for an easier change of dates for our fiscal year, thus making it easier for our members to better understand our annual income and expenditures.

Yes votes = 109 or No votes = 4 PASSED

Addition of NOTE: – The addition of this NOTE will provide additional information about a more detailed Sec/Treas Job Description.

Yes votes = 114 or No votes = 0 PASSED

PBC #5 – Article V, Sec 3.e - Time and Expense...

This slight change to Section 3.e will provide for a new and different (but required) formula for determining the amount of compensation for our current and future eNewline editors.

Yes votes = 114 or No votes = 0 PASSED

PBC #6 – Article V, Sec 7 (re deadlines for announcing candidacy)

This change of date will allow more time for interested candidates to announce their intent to run for offices that are being vacated by incumbents.

Yes votes = 114 or No votes = 0 PASSED

PBC #7 – Article V, Sec 8 – a,b,c, and d – Terms of Office

Should the office of Sec/Treas become an *appointed* position, by the NHPA President and Council? (If so, also some slight changes/adjustments for when VPs would be elected).

Yes votes = 22 or No votes = 92 FAILED

PBC #8 – Article V, Sec 8 – a, also b,c,d – Terms of Office

Should the term length for NHPA Officers be changed from 2 years to 3 years? (If so, also some slight changes/adjustments for when VPs would be elected).

Yes votes = 83 or No votes = 31 PASSED

PBC #9 – Article IX – Convention

Shall the time limit for Charter Presidents to provide a delegate list to the President be changed from 72 hours to 12 hours, and also allow this to be done via e-mail correspondence?

Yes votes = 110 or No votes = 4 PASSED

PBC # 10 – Article VII – Charters

Shall States be allowed to apply for an additional Charter, based on 50 *current* members, or shall they still be required to produce a list of 50 *new* members?

50 **new** members (current wording) = 38 votes, OR

50 **current** members (proposed wording) = 76 votes PASSED

IMPORTANT REMINDER... This next year (2015) is the year for proposed RGS changes, and our NHPA Bylaws state that, "All member-proposed changes to the NHPA Bylaws and **RGS Book** shall be submitted in writing to the respective Committee Chairperson (currently Dan Sanders) and shall be post-marked no later than Dec. 31st of the year (2015) preceding the appropriate Convention. And so in the next few months, please review the RGS Book and if you would like to submit a proposed change for our Rules Committee to consider, please submit this change in writing to me (US mail or by e-mail) by the end of December, as follows: Please include the RGS page number, current wording, your proposed change to the wording (with new wording underlined or italicized), and the reason(s) for this proposed change. Please find my US mailing address and e-mail address listed on page 2 of this Newsletter. A copy of the RGS text information can be found on the NHPA Website, or can be requested from our State Secretary Amy Miller, or by contacting Dick Hansen, NHPA Sec/Treas.

World Tournament Judging Clinics... A Big Success! Although Judging Clinics have been offered at past World Tournaments, this Clinic was unique in that it included a 'classroom session' where 20 selected True/False – Yes/No questions were selected and used as a basis of discussion, for situations that are more likely to occur during the course of tournament play. A power-point presentation was also developed and was very useful during this discussion. In addition, several table-top 'pit models' were available for demonstrating and discussing the use of measuring tools, including the 'bridge tool' (ever hear of this one?) These sessions lasted from 45 minutes to an hour, depending on participation and questions. Over the two-week tournament, no less that 56 pitchers attended one of these clinics, and the overall response was very favorable. Someone even said, 'Every pitcher should be required to attend this clinic, whether they plan to become a judge or not! If they did, there would be a lot fewer *problems* out there on the courts.'" And so, if you ever have an opportunity to attend one of these Judging Clinics, please do! All of these written materials, and also most of the 'pit models', have now been sent to 5 different Charters (including Ohio) where qualified members will be offering these Clinics to you and to other members! Please plan to attend one of these Clinics! Special thanks are extended to Rich Altis, Roy Evans, Bob Bastel, Bob Beagle, and Stacy Robinson/Sanders for the development of these materials, and for helping me with these presentations. Thanks also to our many Judges for attending these clinics and helping to advance the qualifications of our World Tournament Judges!

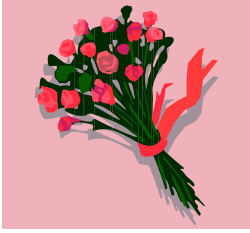

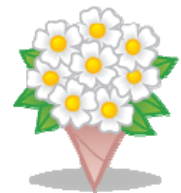
James E. Smith

RUTH RIFE

Inducted into the Ohio Hall of Fame

Ruth Rife, and her husband Virgil, reside at 22016 Euler Road, Weston, Ohio 43569. Both Virgil and Ruth have been active in horseshoe pitching for several years, and both have been far above average in pitching skills. Their daughter, Nikki, pitched for one year but no longer pitches.

Unlike many horseshoe pitchers, Ruth did not grow up in a horseshoe pitching family. She and Virgil pitched in local leagues in Bowling Green between 1990 and 1994. They began pitching in sanctioned events in 1994. Virgil became an accomplished pitcher from the 40' distance often exceeding 70%. After turning 70, he switched to the 30' distance and is one of the best pitchers in the world. He was inducted into the Ohio Hall of Fame in 2013. Ruth also developed into an excellent pitcher. Ruth was one of those people who demonstrated almost instant improvement. After averaging 40% in her first sanctioned tournament in 1994, she started averaging over 70% by 1995. Ruth has an excellent delivery and utilizes a one flip as many top women pitchers do.



Ruth graduated from Van Wert High School and was active in the school band. Like her husband, Ruth enjoyed playing softball for several years. Ruth also excelled in bowling. She has received numerous awards for high game, high series, and team championships. Ruth was inducted into the Bowling Green Bowling Hall of Fame in 1998. Ruth operated a ceramic shop in the late 60's and early 70's. After Nikki was born, Ruth became a fulltime homemaker.

Ruth's pitching performances leave no doubt that she meets the requirements for the Ohio Hall of Fame. Since she started pitching in sanctioned events in 1994, Ruth has had 45 tournaments over 70%. Her best tournament was 76.8% at the Curley-Baker Tournament in Toledo in 1998. Ruth's highest individual game was 88.5%.

STATE TOURNAMENT RECORDS

Ruth won the Ohio State Women's Championship in 2005, 2008, and 2012 having competed in the Championship Class 16 times. Ruth was runner-up 6 times, and finished third 5 times. She averaged over 70% three times and has always exceeded 60% in all State Tournament appearances. Her record is listed to the right. Her record for all 16 appearances is 76 wins and 30 losses for a winning percentage of 71.7.

WORLD TOURNAMENT PITCHING

Ruth and Virgil have not pitched in many World Tournaments. However, in 2003 they traveled to Eau Clair, Wisconsin to participate in the World Tournament. Ruth was not intimidated by the atmosphere. In the preliminaries, she finished second with a record of 12 wins and 3 losses and a ringer% of 69.67. This performance qualified her for the Championship Class of 24 women. Ruth finished 10th with a record of 13 wins and 10 losses with a ringer% of 69.2. She had two games of 81% in the finals. This was an impressive first tournament.

In 2008, Ruth pitched in the World Tournament in York, Pennsylvania participating in the Senior Women's Division. She finished 5th with a ringer% of 69.46. She threw 73.9% against Rivers Prewette who averaged over 80% in winning the Senior Division.

In 2012, Ruth participated in the World Tournament in Knoxville, Tennessee. Ruth finished 4th in the Senior Women's Division with a record of 3 wins and 4 losses and a ringer % of 65.18. She had one game of 84.62% against Jane Schrantz.

The National Horseshoe Pitchers Foundation was formed as a charitable public foundation to raise funds necessary to build and maintain the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association Hall of Fame and Museum. The NHPF continues to solicit tax-deductible contributions to preserve the history, showcase the present and build the future of horseshoe pitching, through grants and educational programs

NHPF Grant Application

In August of 2002, the NHPF Directors approved the formation of modest program that would provide grants to assist in the construction of new or the upgrade of older horseshoe courts on public property. Currently, this program has a cap of six grants per year, none to exceed \$3000.

There are two review periods each year, March and September. Applications must be received by the 1st day of either of these months to be included in that review period. No more than one-half of the annual grant allotment will be issued during March but should there be less, the difference will be added to September so as to allow up to the yearly maximum. Applicants will be notified of approval or rejection by the end of the review months.

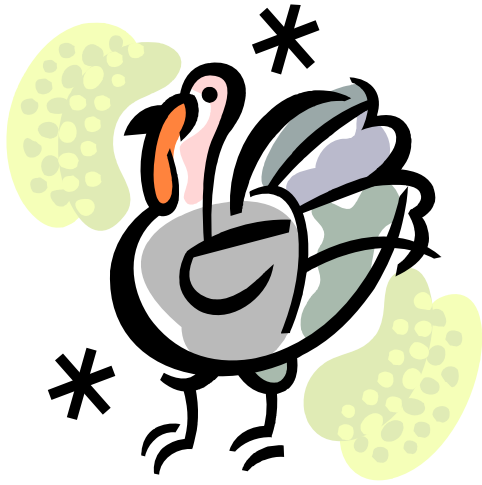

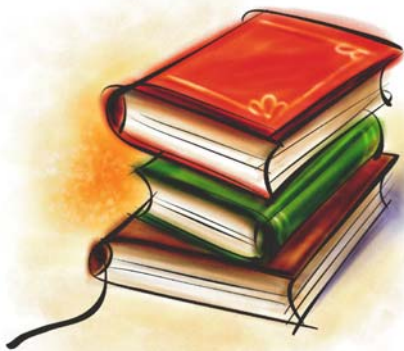

At the Courts with our Tournament Director **CINDY ROSE**

She currently pitches in the Women's division with original Imperials, Dead Soft, 2 lbs – 10 oz shoes. Cindy focuses on the middle of the stake as she steps forward with her left foot throwing a 1 ¼ turn with her right hand thinking nice and slow and to follow through. Her goals are to pitch in Class A at the state level and championship class at the World Tournament. She says "Aim big or go home!!" The highest ringer percentage she earned in a single game was 70.6%. Her recent accomplishment was winning her class at the 2014 World Tournament. This is quite an effort as she missed almost a year and a half due to shoulder surgery. Her toughest opponent is her husband, Dave Rose, because he intimidates her. She indicated that he skunked her twice in tournament play and she still married him! The pitcher that most influenced her game was Elden and Rita Sarbaugh. She stated, "I first started pitching in their old garage. Elden strongly encouraged me to pitch from 30' instead of 40'. I beat the heck out of his garage but I finally calmed down. Pitching against Elden and Rita made me want to be a better pitcher." In her opinion, the best pitcher is Alan Francis because he has his pitch down to a science. He is so consistent, smooth, focused and confident. Cindy currently works in the finance department for the American Red Cross and also enjoys camping, gardening and spending time with her family. Cindy encourages others to, "Enjoy the game as much as Old Man Brown does!! Just pitch your game and try to improve with every tournament". 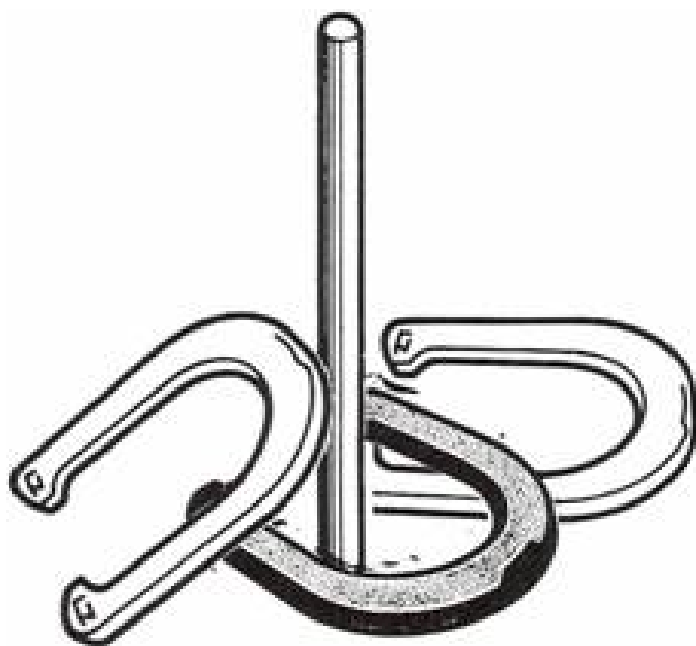
